Maintenance Tips and Tricks

Gas Fireplace	 Double check the emergency gas valve is turned on. Confirm the pilot light is lit. If not, this video can help. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yeCB15rB69g&feature=emb_title
Mold and Mildew	Visit <u>treatitlikedirt.com</u> for information on treating common mold and mildew inside your home.
Window Moisture	 Condensation is caused by high humidity in your home. Always run the bathroom fan while showering, and continue to run it for a least 15 minutes afterwards. Use the vent fan in the kitchen when cooking. Consider using a dehumidifier in your home.
Clogged Toilet	 Never flush these down the toilet: Floss, Grease, Oil & Fat, Band-Aids, Medications, Disposable Wipes, Paper Towels, Feminine Hygiene Products, Cat Litter, Condoms or Hair. Check YouTube.com for dozens of great tips to unclog a toilet.
Toilet Water Shutoff	 Look for the valve located behind your toilet on the LEFT. Turn the knob to the RIGHT (clockwise) to close the valve and stop water flow. https://www.youtube.com/watch?time_continue=1&v=iWjn3E7HiuM&feature=emb_title
Sink Water Shutoff	 Locate the water lines leading to the water valve under the sink. Turn the water valves to the RIGHT (clockwise) to stop the water flow. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WCpHFewA3Ew&feature=emb_title
Fixing your Airconditioner	 Check and replace your filter if needed. 95% of all service calls are simply dirty air filters. Change the filter every three months. Check the thermostat settings. The fan should be set to "auto" and the system set to "cool." Check the furnace. If it is not making noise, check to see that it's plugged in. Check the circuit breaker. The furnace and A/C will have their own dedicated breakers. Make sure the drain line is not clogged. Check the fan unit outside. Is it spinning and clear of leaves and branches?
Change A/C and Furnace Filters	 Locate the air-intake grill that holds the filters. These are normally found on an interior wall or ceiling, and there is often more than one. Open the grill and remove the old filter. Replace with the same sized filter. Important: the air flow arrow on the filter should point towards the direction air is being sucked into. Check your filter monthly. A good habit is when you pay rent each month. Fixing a Garbage Disposal	 Before anything, make sure the power is off. It can be unplugged and/or you can flip the breaker switch. Press the reset button located at the bottom of the disposal. If that doesn't fix the problem, use your hand or cooking utensil to reach down the drain and turn the drums back and forth to break loose any jammed items. Retrieve or remove objects causing a jam. Cleaning Grout Stains	 Toilet bowl cleaner is a great way to clean grout lines. Be sure to use gloves to protect your skin. Apply a thin line along the grout line and let it sit for a few minutes. Wipe away with a damp cloth. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gg5J_qCE5tE&feature=emb_title
Circuit Breakers & GFCI Outlets	 Some outlets are special GFCLs located near areas of water (kitchen and bathrooms). If they are overloaded with power, they will "trip" and stop providing electricity. Press the red reset button on the plate. If that does not work, check all the GFCL outlets in the home and reset, as they are sometimes tied together. If there is still no power to the outlet, check for flipped switches at the circuit breaker panel. https://www.youtube.com/watch?time_continue=34&v=trLeLJdMWWI&feature=emb_title
Refrigerator water dispenser	 The filter for your fridge water dispenser should be changed every six months. Each fridge will have it's own unique filters and sysemts, check online for your fridge make and model. If the water is slow, you probably need to change the filter. Manufacturers will have tutorial videos online.
Gas Range / Stove	 If your gas stovetop is "clicking and won't start, it's usually cause by wet burners. If they appear wet, turn your oven on to 350 degrees for 30 minutes. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-vG9QQDiFCw&feature=emb_title
Smoke Detectors	 If you hear a "chirping", disconnect the smoke detector by twisting counter-clockwise. Replace the battery. If it is still chirping, remove the batter and hold down the test button for 15 seconds to remove any remaining charge.
